**WHEREAS**, families who read and learn together encourage lifelong reading and learning; and

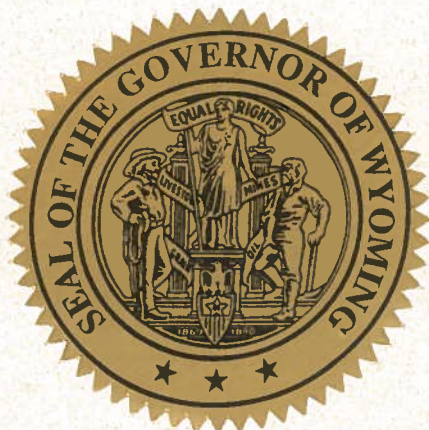
**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Wyoming salute the dedicated professionals and volunteers who encourage literacy in Wyoming's communities for readers of all ages.
